- ⇒ Feb 8: Presidential Polls open at 11:00 You can register to vote and vote on election day. Please be sure to bring your ID with you.
- ⇒ Feb 8: The Public Meeting to review the 2016 Budget will be held at 7 PM at the Randolph Town Hall meeting room. All residents are invited to attend.
- ⇒ Absentee ballots can be gotten from the Town Clerk. All absentee ballots must be mailed back or handed in person to the Town Clerk. The new law does not allow for any sliding of the ballot under the door or dropping into the mail drop box. Any ballot that the Clerk cannot verify was delivered by the absentee ballot requester will not be counted! In the event you cannot mail it in time or hand deliver it to the clerk, a family member (spouse, sibling, child or parent) can bring it to the clerk and fill out the absentee ballot return form in the presence of the clerk (RSA 657:15). If you object to this law contact your state representative.
