MINUTES OF MEETING – May 9, 2016

The meeting began at 7:39 PM.

Minutes of the April 25, 2016 meeting were reviewed and signed.

Vouchers were reviewed and signed.

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**DISCUSSION ITEMS AND MOTIONS:**

Doug Grant, representative of Randolph for North Country Council Scenic By-ways Committee came to the selectmen to update them on the progress of the committee. He presented maps of the scenic by-ways and samples of the Presidential Range by-way and a Woodland by-way signs, the committee wants to post along US Route 2 in Randolph. They're asking for the town's assistance in placing the signs. Kevin noted the town is not equipped to dig the holes required and would have to contact District 1 DOT and enlist their help.

Kevin Rousseau stated road grading will begin May 10<sup>th</sup>. The 2010 truck is in for repairs, the EGR cooler needs to be replaced and the inner air cooler as well. The total repair is expected to be \$ 5000.00 to \$ 6000.00.

John Turner requested Kevin to use the town's pressure washer to clean the Town Hall and Library.

We are still waiting to hear from area towns as to companies they used for Surveillance Cameras. John Scarinza gave a third name and we will be developing an RFP to send out for bids.

A scope of work has been drawn up for the dredging of the Ravine House Pool. Invitations to bid will be placed in the area newspapers and all bids will be required to be returned by May 23<sup>rd</sup>. The selectmen will meet on May 27<sup>th</sup> to review the bids. The Randolph Foundation Ravine House Pool Committee will be notified of the date and time.

Steve Hartman has expressed an interest in the opening and closing of the Ravine House Pool position. An invitation will be extended to Steve to attend the next board

meeting to discuss the position. It was noted that this should include maintenance and placement of any safety devices for the area.

The board reviewed the contract with the contractor regarding High Acres Road. There is no written description of any wet spots located on the road prior to re-construction. Kevin stated the road where the wet spot is located is showing signs of the gravel being pushed off into the ditch area. Board members will visually check High Acres Road for the wet spots to determine further action.

The board received a request from the Conservation Commission to re-appoint Bruce Kirmmse to the commission. John Turner made a motion to re-appoint Bruce, Lauren Bradley seconded the appointment. All Agreed.

Linda gave an update on the Grant for the emergency generator for the Municipal building and the grant to replace the box culverts at the East End of Durand Road.

The board signed the MS-535 – 2015 Financials for the State of New Hampshire. Linda stated the town auditors have scheduled a review of the MS-535 for this Friday.

John Turner made a motion to adjourn at 8:40 PM. Lauren Bradley seconded. All Agreed.
