He asked that \$3,250 be included for Tara Bamford for the next phase of her work on the Land Use ordinances. An increase was included for minutes, as some of the meetings are public hearings, and \$100 was included for books and materials. John Turner advised that Scarinza will need to submit the budget to the town office to be included in the report for the budget hearing on Monday.
