DISCUSSION ITEMS AND MOTIONS:

The board asked Kevin to respond to a damaged culvert on Boothman Lane. He was also asked to clear brush along roadways, in particular at intersections. He reported that the mowing contractor should be coming to mow the first week of Sept. It was agreed the Ravine House Pool should be closed effective Sept. 15. Lauren will ask the contractor to begin removing the boards from the dam after that date. Kevin reported on the brushing activity at the old landfill site and showed pictures of the brush they have removed. This project will be on-going.

As both Michele and Lauren will be out of town on Sept. 11, which is Primary Election day, John Turner will fill in as ballot clerk for the day. The board reviewed the voting booths and voting tables which will be used for the first time Sept. 11.

Michele reported that Dennis Thompson called and said the culvert being constructed for the bridge at the west end of Durand Road will be out of production the last week of Sept. and ready to be installed mid-October. A package was received from Right Angle Engineering with the final DES permit application. It should be approved on time.

Sarah Eusden Gallop brought to the board's attention the purchase of a trails easement on R10 lot 7 which is located at the end of Randolph Hill Road adjacent to the trailhead.

Phil Guiser asked if the high school students could put a coat of finish on the picnic tables at the Ravine House site. This project will fulfill community service hours for the kids. It was agreed they could proceed with the project, but should not use paint or stain, rather a waterproofing finish.

Lauren reported that she got signs for Valley Road indicating "Slow for Children."

John Turner motioned to adjourn at 7:45 PM. All agreed.
