- IV. Income: LandVest \$3,941.21 Hardwood Timber Sales from Farar Property
- V. NRCS Bridge Project updates to the bids are needed, since prices have changed so much from the time the project began. NRCS required that the plans be re-stamped by an NH Certified Engineer. In addition to the bridges that need to be fabricated, bids from contractors to do the work must also be obtained. The general total costs should be in the area of \$300,000, of which NRCS provides \$208,000, in the form of a grant. The Commissioners supported to move forward with this project for 2022/2023
- VI. David DeGruttola was asked to review any salvage timber sales that needs to be done during the Winter of 2022/2023. This would be additional cleanup from the Eastern Tent Caterpillar, which hit the RCF.
