- II. Minutes of the July 2022 meeting were read, and approved.

III. Expenses:

- a. LandVest \$618.00 for services during August 2022, mostly related to followup on the bridge project, and 2022 Forest Day.
- b. Brian Lamarre \$1,406.00 for Brush Mowing on the Farrer From Property 19 hours at \$74.00 per hour.
- IV. NRCS Bridge Project These four bridges are in production and should be shipped to the Randolph Forest for storage in the winter of 2022/23 and installation will take place in 2023.
- V. Wildlife Highway Crossing Project Brad Meiklejohn and Pete Steckler were in attendance to make a presentation for the Bowman Wildlife Highway Crossing Project.
- VI. Glade Skiing David Willcox reviewed the MOU for this project, which gives the RFC authority to ask the Glade Skiing organizers to help maintain parking and traffic issues that have come up over the past few years. John Scarinza will invite Granite State Alliance to attend a RFC meeting to discuss some resolutions to these issues. Some concerns to address are:
 - 1. GSA should provide a Parking Attendant to manage flow.
 - 2. Be responsible for dealing with guide services and larger groups of skiers through permitting, timing and limiting car traffic.
 - 3. Can GSA put information on their website to mention the parking hours, limits and other concerns.
