## **DISCUSSION ITEMS AND MOTIONS:**

Sharon Penney brought in a signed easement for the East End Durand Road turnaround. She also provided a signed MOU for finishing the East End of Durand Road. John Turner and Paul Jadis reviewed and agreed to the MOU for finishing that end of the road.

Chuck Lowe has agreed to allow the town to place a turnaround on the South Side of Durand Road on the property he owns. He has picked up the paperwork and is willing to sign the easement.

Judy Kenison brought in a signed MOU for the work to be done in front of her property on Durand Road.

Nicom LLC has been doing the crack sealing on Randolph Hill Road for the past five years. Paul Kenison has been attempting to reach them since May, to no avail. Finally contacting them in August the company stated they were unable to schedule the work this year.

Paul Kenison reviewed the scope of work for High Acres Road. This will be discussed when Michele Cormier returns from vacation.

Paul Jadis stated the importance of developing a yearly maintenance schedule for the maintenance of the ditches on Durand Road, making sure the ditches are clear of debris and roots and flowing smoothly.

Paul Jadis suggested downloading a weather app with 4 residents in town so that Paul Kenison could keep in contact with the snow levels. The APP is based on GPS and can be acquired at no charge.

Mark Kelley contacted Paul Kenison regarding the driveway at Lydia Eusden's property on Randolph Hill Road. They have decided to move the entrance of their existing driveway and would need a permit.

The board reviewed and approved two Building Permits. One for Dan Aldrich and another for Scott Baldwin, both on Valley Road and both for sheds.

Paul Jadis gave an update on the progress of Durand Road, stating the project is moving along and they are approximately 1-day behind schedule. Considering how wet this summer has been, it was agreed this is more than acceptable.
