DISCUSSION ITEMS AND MOTIONS:

John Scarinza began by stating, due to a frozen water line from the spring to Carol Horton’s house, Carol Horton and Dr. Lake were without water. With the permission of selectmen, a temporary line has been laid from the Town Hall to Carol Horton’s house to accommodate both houses.

John Scarinza also spoke about acquiring 200+ acres from the Town of Gorham. This is part of the Gorham Town Forest located in Randolph. The portion in question would enable easy access to the Randolph Town Forest located on that end of town. Mr. Scarinza has stated that the Conservation Commission has held a public meeting and approved the purchase of this land with donated funds.

Lauren Bradley moved to approve the purchase by the Conservation Commission with donated funds. John Turner seconded. All approved.

Michele Cormier reviewed the new procurement policy as suggested by Heidi Lawton of NH Homeland Security in order to be eligible to obtain FEMA funding if needed. Michele Cormier moved to accept the new Procurement Policy. John Turner seconded. All agreed.

Michele Cormier drafted a letter to newly elected officials and those who have been in office to remind them of Randolph’s concerns of the rail trail and its usage. Lauren Bradley moved to send the letter to the elected officials. John Turner seconded. All agreed.

There is a class action suit going on regarding the Moderator’s authority to postpone or dismiss Town Hall Meeting or Town Hall Elections. John Turner moved to join this suit. Lauren Bradley seconded. All agreed.

The board reviewed and signed a PA-7 Intent to Cut form for Haven Neil, Forester for the Town of Gorham. A certificate of bond was attached.

The smoke detectors and CO detectors have been purchased and are at the Fire Station. Chief Horn will place and install them in the Town Hall where needed.

The next board meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 29th at 7PM.
