DISCUSSION ITEMS AND MOTIONS:

The board reviewed and approved two building permits:

20-19	Jean Malick	Solar Array
21-19	John Weatherly	Solar Array

The board reviewed the bids presented for the insulation of the Cross Meeting Room. Lauren Bradley moved to accept the bid of Sprayfoam & Cellulose. Michele Cormier seconded. All agreed.

After meeting with the engineer, the board realizes that progress to reconstruct Durand Road is still in the pre-construction phase. According to Burke York’s survey DES permits will be needed for the culvert replacements located by Auvern Kenison’s property and Nate Peters property. Erin Darrow suggested the Conservation Commission draft a letter on behalf of the town regarding the need to expedite the Wet Lands permit process and will provide the proper language needed.

Moving forward, the board discussed the top coating of Randolph Hill Road. This will be done in three phases (1) Sealcoat the existing roadway, (2) correct the height of the catch basins to be more efficient, and (3) apply one inch of pavement to the road.

Lauren Bradley volunteered to complete the application for US Route 2 Road Safety Audit as suggested by North Country Council. Lauren also volunteered to draft a letter regarding the NH DOT 10-year plan and the needs of US Route 2 in Randolph.

The board discussed drafting a “Permit to Assemble”. With the attention brought into Randolph with large crowds, weddings and the upcoming bi-centennial of the Town, the board feels that when large crowds gather, certain safety issues needs to be addressed for all concern.
