DISCUSSION ITEMS AND MOTIONS:

The American Legion has removed the crosses at the Memorial Site as scheduled. The crosses have been placed in the Town Forest garage. Lauren Bradley volunteered to contact the Governor’s Office in writing regarding his remarks on WMUR on November 5<sup>th</sup> in reference to the site.

The board reviewed and approved one Demolition permit:

The board reviewed and approved a septic permit for 600 Durand Road.

Lauren Bradley drafted a letter regarding the 10-year plan of NH DOT siting the need to revisit the needs of US Route 2 within Randolph, that was not included in their outline of the 10-year plan. All board members signed the letter.

Due to the diligence of the Town’s Volunteer Fire Department members during this last year, the board reviewed the budget and agreed to divide the budgeted amount to all the volunteers as an appreciation for their efforts due to the unforeseen activities on US Route 2.

The board agreed to review RSA Chapter 286 for handling of public events and/or assemblies within Randolph. This will be discussed at the 2020 Town Meeting in March.

Michele Cormier reviewed her research of Randolph Hill Road. It is 1.7 miles long with 14 catch basins, some need to be raised and others lowered. This is a consideration for 2020 paving project – to be advertised for bids and to invite those that have responded to Michele’s inquiries to bid as well.

John Turner voiced concerns of the dirt roads and asked if they could be graded twice a year. The town has purchased a rock rake and it can be done without using an outside contractor. The board agreed to grading the dirt roads twice a year.

Michele Cormier moved to adjourn at 7:50 PM.
