MINUTES OF MEETING – November 23, 2020

Vouchers were reviewed and signed.
Minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

DISCUSSION ITEMS AND MOTIONS:

The town has received two certified letters from Dennis Tupick:
The first letter addressed a Driveway Permit as requested from the Board of Selectmen to make permanent a temporary driveway at his property located at MAP R15 Lot 9-B. The board reviewed and signed the Driveway Permit.

Mr. Tupick also stated that he does not acknowledge the town’s right of way on Durand Road. The board has noted that the town has a right of way of 25 feet from the center of Durand Road and cannot guarantee any financial for any damage that may occur from plowing throughout the winter months to objects within the right of way.

The second certified letter from Mr. Tupick focused on storm water draining onto his property at this location as well. The board stated that property owners are responsible to control or divert water drainage on their own property.

Lauren Bradley noted she has received a call from a resident concerned with rocks being placed in the Israel River to prevent erosion. This is beyond the boards scope of control and would need to be addressed with NH DES. Also, it was brought to Selectmen Bradley’s attention that there is an issue at the old Bowman Bunkhouse regarding an oil tank. The board has referred this to NH DES as well.

Kevin Rousseau has met with Lee Corrigan regarding the work to be done on the sides of Randolph Hill Road. After reviewing the estimate, this bid would need to go out to bid in the spring.
