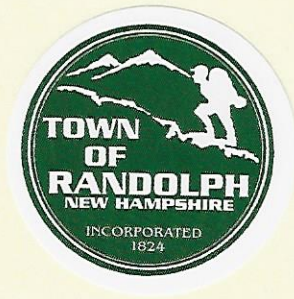


CERTIFICATE OF RIGHT TO BURIAL

KNOWN TO ALL BY THOSE PRESENT:

That this certificate acknowledges receipt of \$_____ which was submitted along with your Application to Purchase, and the right to burial in the lot named below.

On the date of _____ reserves your right of burial in lot # _____ located in Section _____ of the Randolph _____ Cemetery, and includes perpetual care.

You, your heirs and assigns will be entitled to determine who will be buried in your lot. The Randolph Cemetery Trustees retain the right to review each future proposed burial, or up to six (6) cremation on said lot, to assure adequate capacity and conformity within the laws and regulations of the State of New Hampshire as well as the Town of Randolph and to help maintain our mandated records.

This payment does not represent the purchase of land, but rather the use of it for burial purposes. Such right of burial is not an absolute right of property, but is instead a privilege or license to be enjoyed so long as the place continues to be used as a burial ground, and subject to municipal regulations and control. This is a legally revocable right whenever public necessity requires. If, for fifty (50) years the holder of the lot leaves the space unused, the Cemetery Trustees, at their discretion, may institute forfeiture proceedings.

In return for the fee just paid, you, your heirs and assigns have all the privileges and rights belonging to lot holders, which are subject to any rules and regulations as now written and in the future for the protection and preservation of the Cemetery.
