DISCUSSION ITEMS AND MOTIONS:

Workshop meeting

The board discussed the proposal from the Energy Committee to have an audit performed at the library and municipal building. A grant is available to offset 75% of the cost. Michele moved to approve the audit with the caveat that the grant is accepted. John seconded and all were in favor

Paul moved to affirm and accept the litigation offer made by the attorney in the Thompson bridge dispute. John seconded and all were in favor.

The board went into nonpublic session at 6:15 and returned to public session at 6:35.

Paul is meeting with the engineers to set up the zoom public meeting scheduled for June 13. He is working out the technical details for use of the large meeting room. He was asked to request preliminary plans for advance distribution to residents. Regarding project costs, it was determined that even with a volatile economic environment, we should use the most recent available data and simply state that prices are in flux. This includes the costs of the project and financing costs. Michele will provide her financing data to Paul for inclusion in the public meeting presentation.
