CMA sent a multi-page document regarding an invitation to bid and easements for the turn-arounds on the West and East End of Durand Road. CMA has dues dates for the bids as the first week of March. All agreed that this should be adjusted until after the town meeting.

The board approved a building permit renewal for Dennis Tupick.

REEP committee recommended the Town join the Community Power Coalition with all the North Country Towns. Stating, the group agreed that there may be a real advantage to have a representative from the Town join the Coalition. The Coalition has access to current information and updates on the rapidly changing and expanding energy sector and the possible cost savings available to Towns.

John Turner moved to go with the recommendation. Paul Jadis seconded. All agreed.

The board reviewed the proposed budget to be presented at the Public Hearing, on February 13th.
