MINUTES OF MEETING- July 10, 2023

The meeting began at 6:05 pm
Vouchers were reviewed and signed.

DISCUSSION ITEMS AND MOTIONS:

The board signed the PA-16 Application for Reimbursement to Municipalities in Which Federal and State Forest Land is Situated, for the USA National Forest payment in lieu of taxes.

The board signed the PA-28 – Inventory of Property for the year 2024.

Michele Cormier moved to accept the amendments to Article XVI, Section 2 of the Joint Powers Agreement of the Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire as presented and voted on at the CPCNH Annual Meeting on April 21, 2022. Paul Jadis seconded. All agreed.

The board approved abating the portion of tax assessed on a house located on Map U2 Lot 8, which was placed on the tax card in error. The lot in question is land only.

The board approved two building permits, one for Marty Johnson and one for Newell White.

Paul Kenison reviewed road issues with the board. The winter sand buildup on gravel roads can be pulled out with the plow in the fall. The development of cut-offs can help with drainage. To repair Randolph Hill Road across from the Kelleys, Paul suggested the ledge pack would be the best way rather than gravel.

Paul Cormier and Yvonne Jenkins came before the board to review the options for the energy projects. (Solar, heat pumps, electric car chargers) They stated that a grant came with an 80/20 match which includes the Municipal Building. The REEP Committee would like to get Solar for the Town Hall. They asked about the \$40,000 approved to place in the Energy Trust, for the last two years at the Town Hall Meeting, if the town can approve an additional \$9000, this could be accomplished this year.

Michele Cormier stated the town cannot borrow funds without the approval of the governing body at the March Town Meeting. Michele suggested the committee look into rebates and in December have a plan to go before the Town Meeting. Paul Jadis stated, there should be a mini-

mum of three bids comparing apples to apples without caveat. The committee should contact Melissa Elander to work on the procedures moving forward.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:55 pm
