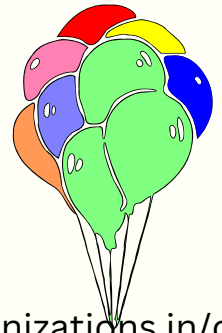


BICENTENNIAL PARADE 2024 RANDOLPH, NEW HAMPSHIRE

Call for Entries

The Parade Committee is looking for community groups, families, and organizations in/or connected to Randolph to showcase and celebrate their past or present contributions to Randolph over the past 200 years.

Theme: Randolph Old and New

Deadline for Entry: Saturday, July 27, 2024

All parade entries MUST be registered to participate.

There is no cost to enter.

Line up begins at 10:00 on the east end of Durand Road.

Parade begins at 11:00 and continues on to the Ravine House Site.

RULES

Each participant must comply with the following rules at all times. We want this to be a safe and fun event for all.

1. Check-In. All entries must check-in no later than one hour before the parade starts. Check-in will take place adjacent to Broadacres Farm on the east end of Durand Road.
2. Please respect the public property and do not park in or block the driveway.
3. Parade Order. The order of the parade is at the discretion of parade officials and may be determined by order of arrival.
4. Parade Flow. All entries must be forward moving and keep a vehicle's length distance between you and the entry ahead at all times. Parade officials will help regulate this.
5. Vehicle Size. Consider the route to the parade, during the parade, and the end of the parade.
6. Drivers. All drivers must have a valid current driver's license.
7. Walkers. Walkers are permitted.
8. Passengers. All riders on floats or vehicles must be securely seated.
9. No articles of any sort (including candy) will be thrown from moving vehicles or floats to spectators. Candy and/or items MUST be handed out (we cannot have spectators running into the street to pick them up)
10. Banners. Please provide your own banner(s) with your group's name that will go in front of your line, float, or on the sides of your vehicle.
11. Animals. Entries with animals are responsible for cleaning up and disposing of any excrement before, during, and after the parade.
12. Garbage. Please bring trash bags and take with you any debris created by your entry.
13. Smoking and Alcohol. No smoking or alcoholic beverages are allowed on any parade entry at any time on the parade route or in the staging area.
14. No solicitation or political campaigning allowed in the parade.
15. Right of refusal. The parade committee reserves the right to refuse or remove any entry, which in their opinion does not conform to parade rules.
16. Cancellations. Rain or shine – the parade will go on.
