The board discussed sending a letter regarding new legislation affecting the investment of trust funds by PDII The Town's trustees of trust funds have drafted a letter opposing the legislation. The board agreed to support the trustees sending this letter and also to send a similar letter of opposition.
The board discussed sending a letter of "requests for proposals" to a limited number of appraisal companies s we might have a new company contracted by year-end when the current contract expires. Michele drafted letter, and Paul agreed to edit it. It should be sent out within the next week.
The board looked at the meeting schedule for the month of May and decided to hold only one more meeting it May, on May 20, rather than the usual May 13 and 27. Meeting time will be 6 pm in the future.
Paul reported that GW Brooks will be performing the completion work on Durand Road beginning the secon week of May. Finish work was cut short last fall by weather. Paul also reported that Lee Corrigan has been given the go ahead to begin demolition of the cabins at Lowe which have been cleared of hazardous materials. Acadia will abate the other cabins and the mail house Michele is to contact the Lowe family to empty out all the cabins which are marked to contain hazardous materials so the abatement company can proceed.
