Chief Horne and Chief Cloutier came before the board to discuss the Randolph Repeater Project. The board had specific concerns regarding the obligations of Randolph for this project. The Town of Gorham received a Grant to cover the cost of placing Repeaters in Randolph, Shelburne, and Gorham to enhance radio contact and secure the safety of individuals in the three towns.

At a total cost of \$71,000.00 for site work at the Randolph location, the grant would fund \$49,500 leaving \$21,500 not covered by the grant. Chief Cloutier presented a breakdown stating the tower foundation and grounding, 6x4 equipment pad and the 25x25x6' fencing is not covered by the grant and explained, the cost of \$21,500 should be covered by Randolph.

The Forest Commission is willing to cover the cost of timber cut and the road work needed for the project.

Chief Horne could not stress enough the need for this project and public safety should be a priority when looking at this project.

Paul Jadis stated he has difficulties, due to the lack of willingness of Gorham working with Randolph on other projects in the past. He also stressed that Randolph is donating the land the repeater will be placed and the building of the road. He continue to add, he wanted to see specific specs for the concrete pads and for the required fencing.

Lucille Lowe submitted an application for Currect Use on the property where the cabins and green house was located, Since, it was noticed that a small playhouse is still staying there. Michele Cormier stated, she would reach out to Kevin and Mark regarding this building.

Michele Cormier noted she would be out of town from March 22nd through the end of April. Paul Jadis will take time away in September.

Rick Fournier noted that he has received one bid and expecting several others for the replacement of the Town Hall Emerency Generator.

Michele Cormier will respond to Loren Martin of Avitar Associates LLC, regarding Mike Cote and the BTLA case concerning his LUCT dispute.

The board reviewed the Durand Road proposal and options of costs to complete the phases not completed in 2023.
