MINUTES OF MEETING
September 8, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 6:03 pm.

Minutes were approved and vouchers signed.

Paul Kenison updated the board on summer activities in town. The roadside mowing has begun, Lee Corrigan will be in town on Tuesday to begin the lower Randolph Hill Road work, Paul K will review the paving of the corrupt area on Durand East Road and shimming of Durand Road bump. He has moved the sander from Lowe's and received the parts necessary for repairs. This will be used as a backup sander if needed. The new bucket for the Backhoe has arrived, Paul K. will pick it up when he brings the Chevy truck in for a recall to save on trips. Paul K. reviewed with the board, complaints on Raycrest Drive of heavy rains washing gravel and water into driveways on the down slope.

The remaining board members signed the Boothman Lane MOU. Paul Kenison noted: by pushing the snow at the end of Boothman Lane toward the catch basin would cause the snow to pack and freeze, this may cause freezing in the drain, and water backing up. John Turner and Michele Cormier noted Paul's comments and signed the MOU. Linda Dupont will make copies and send out to all parties.

The Board reviewed and signed the Debois & King contract to test the Closed Landfill on Valley Road as required by NH DES. This is done bi-annually and will be completed in November.

Building Permits were reviewed:

20-25	Mather	Pergola - Approved
21-25	Cutter	amended permit 19-24 to increase size of a shed on the east-side of the house. - Approved
22-25	Clark	10x10 Tractor Shed - Approved
24-25	Cherry Realty	reconstruct 24 US Route 2 and add a second level. Approved contingent on Septic Inspection and NH DES Approval for a 4-Bedroom home.

The board revisited the Jalbert Building Permit. New information has come before the board and they decided to discuss this with a full board present. This will be brought up again at the next Board of Selectmen meeting to be held in two weeks, on September 22, 2025.

Littleton Sign Shop sent a proof of the Durand Road East sign. The board advised Linda Dupont to reach out to the shop and ask if the letters could be more rounded as in the old style, painted white with the background painted brown. The existing more modern street sign will be removed.
