The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm.

Building Permit was submitted by the Eusden's to add a solar array – the permit was approved with the stipulation that the Solar Company provide a valid Master Electrician License issued by the State of New Hampshire.

A Building Permit was submitted for an addition to the Archambault property on High Acres Road. The Board requested more detailed information of the project.

A Driveway Permit was submitted for the above project; this needs to be inspected and signed off by our Road Agent in order to move forward.

The board spoke about updating the Randolph Emergency Operations Plan and decided to take on the task, due to no grants are available for the project.

Michele Cormier with Paul Kenison and Tim Mather met and reviewed the scope of work to correct the drainage problem at the end of Boothman Lane. With this information they will be able to create a spec sheet for the job to go out for bid in the spring.

The board reviewed expenditures of projects done in 2025 to be funded from funds placed in the Expendable Trust Funds. These requests will be noted the first meeting in November.

After reviewing who is responsible for the individual Expendable Trust Funds, it was discovered that the Trustee of the Trust is responsible for one of the funds. This will need to be addressed and brought before the Town Meeting as a Warrant Article.

An email was received from Edith Tucker commending the Road Agent on the repairs done to Coldbrook Road and the bridge at the entrance. She also noted the repairs to the entrance of Du-rand Road East.

Bill Demers commended Road Agent Paul Kenison for clearing the culvert at the junction of Raycrest Drive and US Route 2.
