Article 05 Special Meeting

Shall, GRS Coop School District, if the cost items are amended or rejected in Article #04, RSA 31:5, III (RSA 197:3 for schools) allows one authorized special meeting without petitioning superior court. "Shall GRS Coop School District, if article is defeated, authorize the governing body to call one special meeting, at its option, to address article cost items only?" Article 06 Open Enrollment

Open Enrollment To see if the GRS Cooperative School District shall vote to adopt the provisions of NH RSA Chapter 194-D and become an open enrollment school district under the terms of the RSA, to admit 2 (two) students from outside the GRS Cooperative School District to grades K-12 with 0% (zero percent) of the resident student population eligible to seek enrollment outside of the District.
