Michele Cormier and Paul Jadis reviewed the letter to Carrie Freitag regarding the fence on Pinkham B Road. After a discussion they determined that there should be no setback for this type of fence, adjusted the letter to read so, they both agreed.

Michele Cormier and Paul Jadis reviewed the Weatherly Building Permit, the subdivision documents presented by June Hammond Rowan and the determination of the Planning Board when granting the Sub-division. The permit was denied due to lack of frontage and referred John Weatherly to the Board of Adjustment.

Paul Jadis signed and dated as Point of Contact for the Town of Randolph with the Attorney's office representing Acadia Insurance Co. on behalf of GW Brooks.
